

HEALTH & SAFETY REPRESENTATIVES TRAINING



Have you thought about becoming a health and safety representative at your work?

All elected health and safety representatives (HSRs) are entitled to undertake WorkSafe Victoria approved occupational health and safety (OHS) training.

This training must be approved by WorkSafe Victoria and will help a HSR to understand and exercise their powers effectively.

HEALTH & SAFETY REPRESENTATIVES INITIAL OHS TRAINING COURSE

This 5 day course covers a range of topics to give you confidence to deal with occupational health and safety issues including:

- Interpreting the OHS legislative framework and its relationship to the HSR.
- Identifying key parties and their legislative obligations and duties.
- Participating in consultation and issues resolution.
- Establishing representation in the workplace.
- Represent designated work group members in any OHS risk management process undertaken by the appropriate duty holder/s.
- Issuing a Provisional Improvement Notice (PIN) and directing the cessation of work.
